MegaLOUD is at Activity World on Friday 15th June, 7:30 pm. All Yr 6s and secondary school students welcome. Turn up on the evening

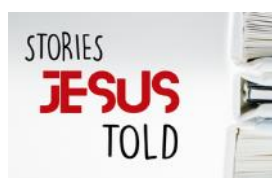
and pay entry fee (£5) when you arrive.

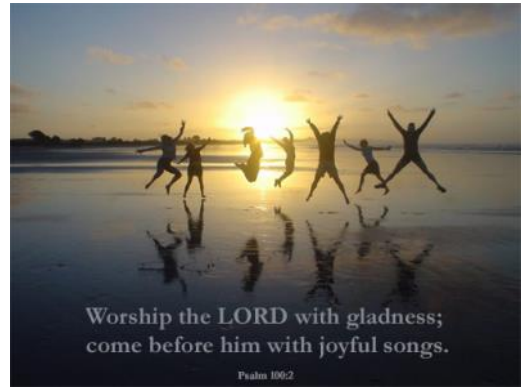
