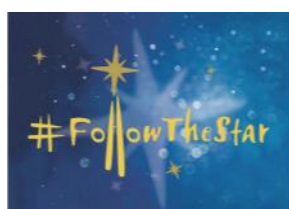
A reminder that **Confirmation** classes start on 1<sup>st</sup> December, in Emmanuel at 9:30 am.
