This is advance notice that a new Electoral Roll is to be prepared in 2019. Every person on the existing roll will be removed and everyone wishing to be on the new roll will need to fill in an Electoral Roll form. These will be available nearer the end of the month. Under GDPR, by completing the form, you agree to your name (not your address) being displayed on the roll which must be affixed near the principal door of each church building for not less than 14 days. Going on the electoral roll entitles you to vote on matters at the church APCM, stand for PCC and provides the church with the ability to contact you regarding stewardship matters. The electoral roll is an indication of the membership of the church and the number on it is reported to the deanery and national church body.

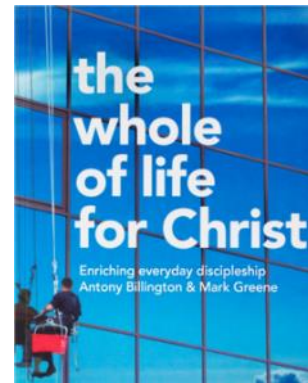
