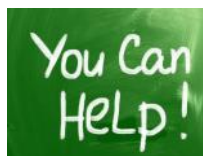
30th June - Cake sale after morning services - last one to raise funds for Soul Survivor.

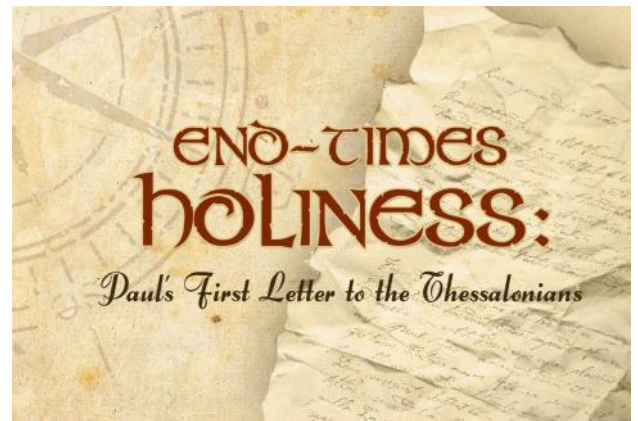
